PRESS RELEASE

The Minister of Finance hereby informs the general public of the launching of the Competitive Entrance Examination into the African Institute of Computer Sciences (IAI) of Libreville in Gabon, in the Conceptual Computer Engineering Cycle for the 2020-2021 academic year.

The Competitive Entrance Examination is open to Cameroonians under the age of 27 on the date of Competitive Entrance Examination, and holders either:

- 1. An HND in Mathematics, Physics or Computer Science or any equivalent diploma;
- 2. A certificate of admission into Level 3 (DMD) in Mathematics, Physics or Computer Science and who validated with 120 points;
- 3. A diploma sanctioning or attesting the end of the training cycle of IAI Computer Analysts, a Technological University Diploma (TUD) in Computer Science or any equivalent diploma;
- 4. A certificate of registration into the second year of the degree cycle (DMD system) in Mathematics, Physics or Computing. These students will be retained only if they have validated the 4 semesters of study, that is, with 120 points;
- 5. A certificate of registration into the second year of the preparatory classes in science. These students will only be retained on the condition that they have obtained an annual average of at least 12/20 at the end of the second year.

The candidate files, which must be deposited latest Friday, NOVEMBER 06th 2020, must include the following:

- A stamped written application with a fiscal stamp of 1000F CFA, addressed to the Director General of IAI, BP 2263 Libreville-Gabon;
- A certified copy of the birth certificate;
- An extract from the criminal record, duly signed not older than three (03) months;
- A certificate of nationality;

A certified copy of the diploma or a certificate of registration in the second year of a science degree, a preparatory class or an IUT or a third year of analyst (IAI) for the current year;

A certified copy of the diploma or a certificate of registration in the second year of a science degree, a preparatory class or an IUT or a

third year of programmer analyst (IAI) for the current year;

• A medical certificate not older than 2 months;

Four (04) colour passport size photograhs;

A receipt confirming payment of the registration fees of 15,000F CFA paid at the various venues mentioned above.

The files will be deposited at the following locations:

• CENADI YAOUNDE, located in the former presidency of the Republic, for candidates wishing to sit in for the tests in Yaoundé;

Douala Computer Centre of CENADI, in the CAMBANIS building in AKWA for candidates wishing to sit in for the tests in Douala:

• Bafoussam Computer Centre of CENADI, for candidates wishing to sit in for the tests in Bafoussam;

• Garoua Computer Centre CENADI, for candidates wishing to sit in for the tests in Garoua.

The competition will take place in two phases:

Psycho-technical tests on November of 2020 in all venues mentioned above;

The written tests on November 14, 2020 in African institute of computer sciences (IAI) Yaoundé for all candidates.
